

Grayson Lake State Park

Sheer sandstone canyons and gentle slopes comprise the 1,512 acres of Grayson Lake State Park. This site was a favorite camping area for Shawnee and Cherokee Native Americans. The hiking trails offer several species of ferns, mosses, and lichens, the flowering rhododendron, "lizard head rock," and the unusual combination of beech-hemlock trees.

The Hidden Cove golf course ranked #4 by "Golf Digest" in its list of "2004 Best New Affordable Golf Courses" and is part of the Kentucky State Park system's "Signature Series" golf courses.

Golf: 18-hole regulation golf course with fully equipped pro shop, rental clubs and carts. Call 866-905-7888 for tee time.


Camping: 71-site campground offers utility hookups, a dump station, and two central service buildings with restrooms, showers and laundry facilities. Reservations on-line or at 1-888-4KY-PARK.

Boating: Launching ramp provides access to lake. Located 3 miles from the park, a marina (606-474-4513) has rental fishing boats and pontoon boats, bait, grocery and restrooms.

Hiking Trail: Two trails, .8-mile Beech-Hemlock Forest Trail and 3-mile Lick Falls Loop Trail.

Recreational Activities: Public beach. Planned recreation and special events. Seasonal.

Picnicking & Playground: Two large picnic shelters, large picnic area with three playgrounds.
