Yatesville Lake State Park

Popular with both anglers and recreational boaters, Yatesville Lake State Park is a 2,300-acre mountain reservoir located in Eastern Kentucky. The Eagle Ridge golf course, built on mountainous terrain, was ranked #3 nationally by “Golf Digest” magazine in its list of 2005 best new affordable golf courses, and is part of the Kentucky State Park System’s “Signature Series” golf courses.

Camping: 47-site campground, 27 full hook up sites and 20 primitive sites – 16 “boat-in” sites and 4 “hike-in” sites. Laundry room, restrooms & showers, and a dump station. The wooded “hike-in” sites have no electricity. The “boat-in” sites are only accessible via boat. Reservations on-line or at 1-888-4KY-PARK.

Fishing: Variety of species such as bluegill, crappie, and bass.

Golf: 18-hole regulation course with fully equipped pro shop, rental clubs, and carts. 866-906-7888 or 606-673-4300

Marina: 140 boat slips, supplies and pontoon and jon boat rentals available. Two launch ramps. 606-686-2361

Hiking Trails: Varied trail systems. The Multi Use Trail is a 20+ mile trail open to hikers, backpackers, mountain bikers and horseback riders.


Recreational Activities: Boating, fishing, hiking & playground
